

? What is a Walking School Bus?

A Walking School Bus is a fun, safe and healthy way to walk to school in a group, guided by parent volunteers...just like a regular bus route, but students are walking instead of riding!

Our Walking School Bus program is open for anyone to participate, regardless if you live in one of the neighborhoods. Walks will be canceled if temperatures are below 35°F or if there is heavy rain or lightning in the forecast. We will update our Facebook page by 8am on any mornings with low temperatures or inclement weather.


When:

Every **Monday** and **Wednesday** morning (weather permitting).

Starts Monday, September 9th! - The walking school bus runs year round. Walk leader on-hand by 8:30am, with walk leaving at approximately 8:35am (look for the sign!).

Where:

Meet in front of the Boundary Village Apartments office (503 Culpepper Hill Ct.), or join in along the route! The full route is 1/2 mile in distance. On-street parking is available along parts of W. Boundary St. and W. Johnson St.



This year, in addition to our Walking School Bus program, we will be running a group bike ride on Fridays! Meet in front of SK8 Cary (Godbold Park) by 8:30am. Parking is available at the park or further down the greenway at Starbucks.

The ride is approximately 1 mile along the Northwoods Greenway, with adults and older students acting as ride leaders. The ride will be canceled if the temperature will be below 45°F or if there is inclement weather.
